Security Clearance Required

Individuals wishing to attend the MILCOM 2010 classified sessions must, at a minimum, be a **U.S. citizen Employed by the U.S. Government, U.S. Owned Firm, or U.S. University** and possess a current U.S. government granted **final SECRET** personnel security clearance. The requirements of DoD 5220-22-M, National Industrial Security Program Operating Manual (NISPOM) and DoD 5200.1-R Information Security Regulation apply. An applicants visitor security clearance information received later than October 15, 2010 risk not being processed in time to attend the classified sessions. **Hand carried or faxed copies will not be accepted at MILCOM registration.**

Penalty for Misrepresentation

Title 18, United States Code 1001, makes it a criminal offense, punishable by a maximum of 5 years imprisonment, \$10,000 fine, or both, to make a false statement of representation to any Department or Agency of the United States as to any matter within the Jurisdiction of any Department or Agency of the United States. This includes any statement knowingly made by an employer or employee herein that is found to be incorrect, incomplete, or misleading in any important particular.
